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RESIDENCE PERMIT APPLICATION FOR CHILD

This form is for you if you are applying for a first Finnish residence permit for a child under the age of 18 on the basis of family ties. The purpose of the application is that the child intends to move to Finland and to lead a family life with his/her guardian. The application may be filed by the child with his/her guardian abroad or the child's guardian as sponsor in Finland. The child must be unmarried for a residence permit to be granted on the basis of family ties between parent and child.

A clarification of family ties must be submitted with this form: a sponsor in Finland must use form PK4_plus and a guardian with the child abroad must use form PH4_plus. However, the clarification of family ties is not needed if the child is applying for a residence permit simultaneously with his/her guardian.

Carefully fill in and sign the application. Incomplete information will delay the processing of the application and may lead to its rejection.

An application may be submitted to a Finnish diplomatic mission abroad or to the local police in Finland. A processing fee will be collected when the application is submitted, according to the Decree on charges. Clarifications that you need to append to your application are listed in Section D of this form.
