For Diocesan Priests: Documents required are mentioned below (Monsignor, Father, Deacon, Diocesan Seminarian)

- Invitation Letter attested by the Secretariat of State in Rome
- Letter from the Local Ordinary (Bishop)
- First and last page of the Passport (with the details of the Applicant)
- Agreement Letter/Contract Letters (Convenzione) mandatory for Priests going for Pastoral Work

The dates of the staying in Italy have to be clearly mentioned in the Agreement Letter/Contract Letters and in the local Superior letter equally.

For Religious Priests and Sisters: Documents required are mentioned below (Brother, Sister, Seminarian, Father, Postulant)

- Invitation Letter attested by the Secretariat of State in Rome
- Letter from the Local Ordinary (Bishop)
- First and last page of the Passport (with the details of the Applicant)
- Letter from the Provincial Superior
- Agreement Letter/Contract Letters (Convenzione) mandatory for Religious going for Pastoral Work
